CWM Internship is a creative, hands on and innovative opportunity for 21-30 years old to experience between 6-12 months to explore faith alongside work in an international mission organization. As CWM is located in six regions, i.e., Pacific, Africa, Europe, Caribbean, East Asia, South Asia, with offices in Singapore, London and Johannesburg, the Internship will involve opportunities to work in one or more of these locations and so be an excellent opportunity to explore and experience a different culture.



Throughout the internship there will be opportunities to work with CWM's teams e.g. programme, finance, communications, etc. This is integrated with opportunities for training and mentoring throughout the internship period which will support your professional, personal and spiritual development.

Who can apply?

- CWM's Internship is open to any young person aged 21-30 years old who is able to commit to working full-time from 6-12 months.
- CWM is an ecumenical and mission organization and so we require Interns to be from a CWM member church or an ecumenical organization with which CWM works.
